## 1. Introduction

This document explains the new additions and enhanced features introduced in the Lepide Active Directory Self Service 17.0.

## 2. New Additions

### 2.1 Enrollment Notifications after User Logon

The administrator can now select Enrollment Notifications to be displayed after the logon. Once this setting has been configured, the following dialog box appears on the screen whenever un-enrolled users log on at their computers of that domain, on which the enrollment policy has been applied.

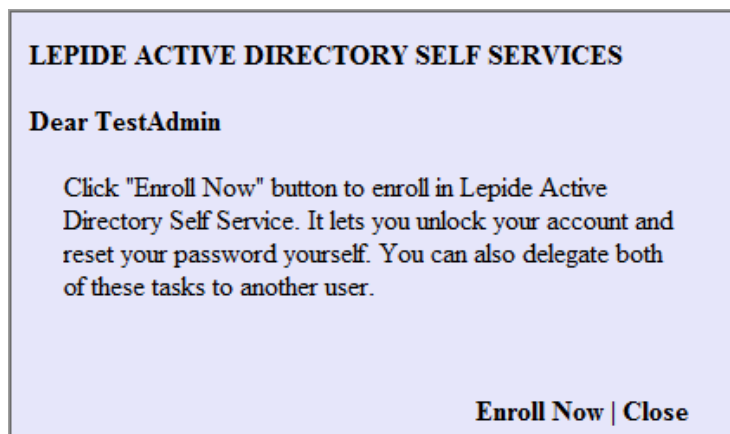



Figure 1: Enrollment Notification after User Logon

## 2.2 Select Date Time Format

In the "Configuration" Tab, "General Settings" have been added. Here, the Administrator can select the format of date and time that is displayed in both Admin and User Consoles.

## 2.3 Updated Integrated API

Java SE Development Kit 8 has been integrated into this latest version of Lepide Active Directory Self Service. These upgraded APIs provide latest security features to users.

# 3. Enhancements

## 3.1 Special Characters in Usernames

Lepide Active Directory Self Service is now able to function when special characters are being used in the username.

## 3.2 Improved Security Questions

Now answers to two or more security questions cannot be same. The user selects these questions at the time of enrollment and they will be asked when a user tries to reset the password.

## 3.3 Minor Bug Fixes

Minor bug fixes offer better functionality for users.
